

**Transportation Public Meeting  
Public Comments Welcomed**

**(Longview, TX)** The Longview Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has scheduled a public meeting on Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. in the Longview City Council Chambers located in the Jo Ann Metcalf Municipal Building, 300 W. Cotton St. The MPO will present revisions to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and revisions to the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). The Longview TIP is a plan, which identifies federally funded highways, bridges, bicycle & pedestrian projects, and Longview Transit public transportation projects to be constructed or implemented in the next four years. The MTP is a federally required, fiscally constrained, performance-based plan that identifies transportation needs for the next twenty-five years. The public is invited to attend and will be given an opportunity to provide comments at the meeting. The meeting will be live streamed on Facebook Live, CityView Municipal TV [LongviewTexas.gov/CityView](https://www.longviewtexas.gov/CityView) and Longview Cable TV, Channel 10. After the meeting, citizens may view the recorded meeting online in the CityView Video Library. A 30-day public comment review period for the Longview MPO Transportation Improvement Program and the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan will be held from April 21 to May 20, 2021.
