## **IX. Action Item**

- A. Consider a Resolution awarding contracts to, and authorizing, and directing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to execute any necessary documents with CentralSquare Technologies, LLC, for a Computer-Aided Dispatch/Mobile Computing Law Enforcement Records Management System & annual maintenance and support. The total amount for software, services, and hardware is \$1,635,632.55. The first year cost for maintenance and subscription is \$365,357.75. An additional Rehosting option is being included within the contract for a total of \$66,690.00. Recurring annual cost for maintenance and subscription for future budget years is \$374,415.24 (YEAR 2), \$383,925.60 (YEAR 3), \$393,925.60 (YEAR 4), \$404,396.65 (YEAR 5), and \$424,616.49 (YEAR 6) – Anthony Boone, Police Chief and Joshua Gamble, Director of Information Services.
