II. **Annexation Hearings**

A. **A PUBLIC HEARING** will be held to consider a proposed annexation of approximately 1.846 acres of land within the city's extraterritorial jurisdiction in Gregg County located at the northeast corner of Judson Road and George Richey Road

Ingrid Self, Assistant Director of Development Services was present and presented the staff report:

This property is located at the northeast intersection of Judson Road and George Richey Road. This is the second of two public hearing required by the local government code to consider a proposed annexation of approximately 1.846 acres of land.

B. **A PUBLIC HEARING** will be held to consider a proposed annexation of approximately 30.927 acres of land within the city's extraterritorial jurisdiction in Gregg County located at the northeast corner of E. Loop 281 and Eastman Road

This property is located at the northeast intersection of E. Loop 281 and Eastman Road. This is the second of two public hearings required by the local government code to consider a proposed annexation of approximately 30.927 acres of land. A portion of this property lies within Tryon Road Special Utility District. The City of Longview will not service this area with water.

Councilman David Wright: So, we are not going to supply water but that part of the property is going to be annexed?

Ms. Self: That is correct, that part of the property is in the CCN.
