

## Spring Hill Comment Responses 11-2-22

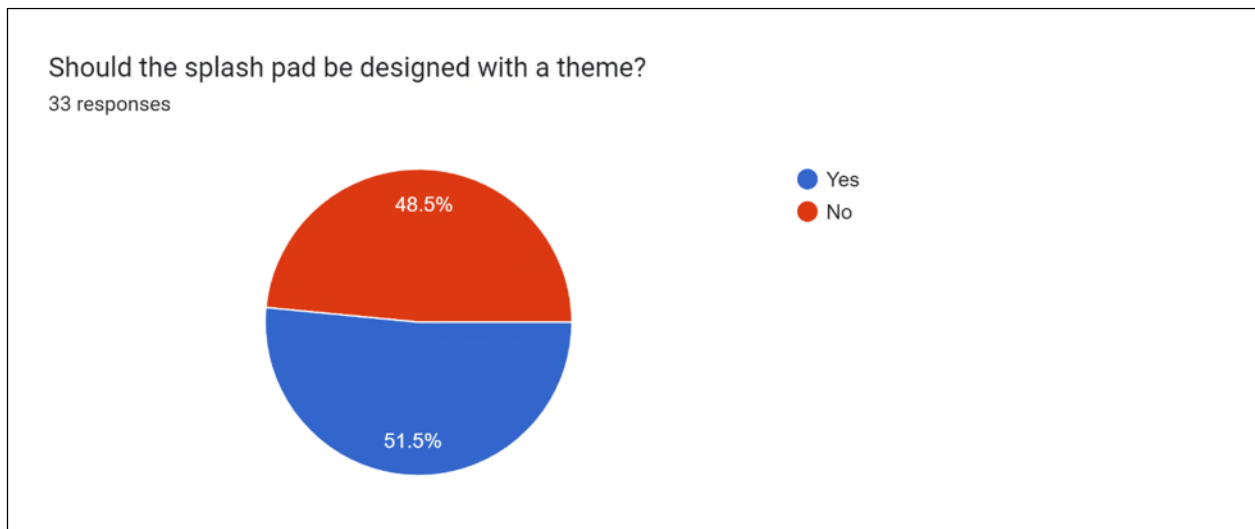
Residents approved a \$24.1 million Bond Proposition in November 2018. The projects included were:

1. Completion of the Lear Park Master Plan
2. Improve Existing Parks
3. Updating Broughton Recreation Center and Park
4. Reconstruct Cargill Long Trail
5. Developing the Arboretum

The existing parks identified for improvements are Lois Jackson Park, McWhorter, Patterson, Spring Creek, Stamper/Womack, Rollins and Spring Hill. The bond issue in February, 2019 provided funding for each of these except Rollins and Spring Hill and a portion of McWhorter. Funding is now in place for these improvements.

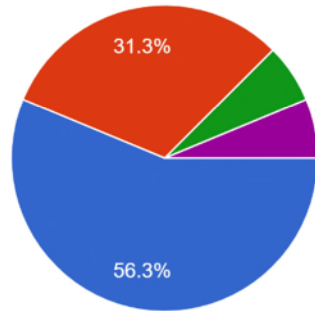
A meeting was held at the Spring Hill High School to present the Concept Plan for Spring Hill Park on October 11. A short presentation provided the priorities for projects and amenities included. Each attendee was asked to review the display boards, and complete and return a survey. The information was also presented at the District 5 Town Hall meeting on October 24. In addition, the survey was promoted through social media and posted on-line for 3 weeks. A total of 33 responses were received.

### What theme would you prefer?

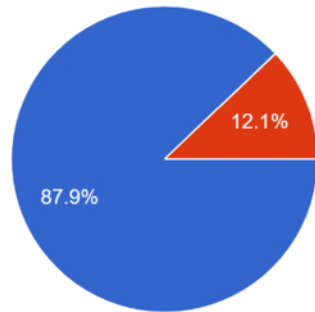

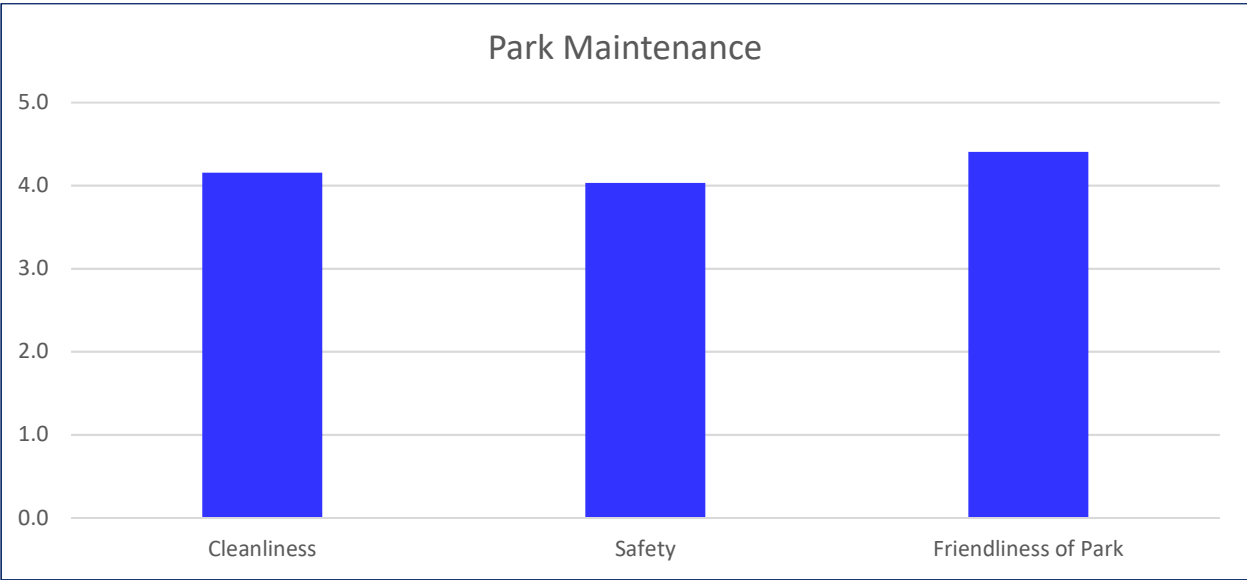
- Animals
