


4. Implement Spring Hill Park master plan
5. Acquire new parkland and increase parkland acres level of service in northwest section

Parks Master Plan Top Priorities

6. Provide new facilities at existing parks
7. Increase park funding and annual budget
8. Continue to raise funds and implement the Longview Arboretum
9. Continue to explore new indoor recreation facilities
10. Continue to explore multiple funding opportunities

- Total Construction Budget - \$1.7 million
 - Trail - \$258,000
 - Pavilions – \$223,000
 - Playground w/ safety surface – \$66,000
 - Basketball court – \$72,000
 - Parking - \$604,000
 - Field Improvements - \$211,000
 - New Entry - \$135,000
 - Site Work - \$143,000
